She said it can be hard to get volunteers.

The organization financially supports youth sports for the local school district as well as a variety of local charities. Establishes foundations within the state organization have been established to support cancer research, diabetes research, scoliosis and spinal cord, heart and kidney funds.

Kohlrieser noted on a more national level the Eagles organization has also been credited with helping to start Social Security and establish Mother's Day as a holiday.

"It's people helping people,"

Kohlrieser said.

She is especially proud of the memorial foundation which helps take care of children's education if their parents die on the job.

One of their upcoming events is a metal recycling effort planned for this Saturday. Recently the Eagles also held a garage sale to help support their charitable giving.

Kohlrieser said they will soon be renovating the Wapakoneta Eagles Building to install a new ceiling and carpet.

"We want to make sure the membership likes what we are doing," Kohlrieser said. While the Eagles host Bingo on Friday nights, they are more known for charity.

Kohlrieser has already im-

mortalized herself in the Ohio Eagles Auxiliary.

In 2019 Kohlrieser was inducted into the Ohio Eagles Auxiliary Hall of Fame — and the Grand Auxiliary Hall of Fame. Kohlrieser explained that you have to be a good standing member for more than 20 years; people write nomination letters for you and a committee decides who is honored.

The last time Wapakoneta Eagles Auxiliary had a state president was in 1973 when Ruth Hasis was in charge. In 1993 the Wapakoneta Eagles were also represented at the state when Moe Fisher served as president.
