**LADIES AUXILIARY RULES AND REGULATIONS CHANGES
APPROVED BY THE BOARD OF GRAND TRUSTEES IN 2020**

PLEASE NOTE: Statutes, Section 37.2. states in part: “The Board of Grand Trustees is hereby authorized and empowered to make, adopt and cause to be promulgated by the Grand Worthy President, rules and regulations with reference to the procedure for the organization, and for the administration and government of all Ladies Auxiliary Units, which rules and regulations shall, so far as may be possible, be in conformity with the Statutes made and provided for the organization, administration and government of the Grand Aerie, and Local, State or Provincial Aeries.”

Section 1.2 No person shall be eligible to be elected to membership in any Local Auxiliary unless such person is a female, is of good moral character, believes in the existence of a Supreme Being, is not a member of a Local Aerie or any other Ladies Auxiliary of the Fraternal Order of Eagles and unless she is over the age of eighteen (18). Nor shall any person, under any circumstances, be eligible to be elected to membership in any Ladies Auxiliary if she is a member of or in any way affiliated with the Communist Party, or **any party or group** who believes in or advocates the overthrow of the government of any country where a Local Auxiliary is located, by force or violence, or who refuses to obey the Rituals which show respect for the government of the country in which the Auxiliary is located.

Section 28.3 ~~If two thirds (2/3) of the members present at such meeting vote in favor of such incorporation,~~ Articles of Incorporation shall be prepared and submitted to the Auxiliary for its approval.

Section 33.1 Immediately after the last day of May each year, the Madam Secretary, Madam Treasurer, and Auditor shall render to the Grand Aerie, an itemized report of all assets and liabilities of, and all changes in the membership of the Auxiliary. The Madam Secretary shall include a copy of the previous year’s IRS Form 990 or its equivalent. If the Auxiliary files an IRS Form 990 or 990EZ and provides a copy to the Grand Aerie, the Auditor is not required to provide an Auditor’s Annual Report. Otherwise the Auxiliary Auditor must comply with the filing requirements of the Auditor’s Annual Report.

June 1st through May 31st of the following year shall be the fraternal and fiscal year for all Auxiliaries. All Auxiliaries, where applicable, shall use this date for Internal Revenue Service (IRS) filings.

Section 37.8 When a Local, State or Provincial Auxiliary is dissolved by surrender or revocation of its charter, such charter, books, papers, jewels, emblems, regalia and other effects necessary to conduct the ceremony of the Ritual, shall become the property of the Grand Aerie. Other property, real and personal, shall vest in the Grand Aerie, to be by it applied towards the payment of debts of the Local, State or Provincial Auxiliary, and the balance, if any, shall be held in trust by the Grand Aerie for a period of ten (10) years from the date of dissolution of the Local, State or Provincial Auxiliary, ~~to be delivered to the~~ **With approval of the Board of Grand Trustees, all or part of these funds may be allocated to any** new Local Auxiliary which may be chartered in the State/Province where the dissolved Auxiliary was located.

Section 47.1 The Grand Auxiliary shall meet at the same time and place, annually as the Grand Aerie.

In the event the annual regular session(s) cannot be held, due to national or regional disaster or some other unforeseen circumstances, the officer positions of the Grand Auxiliary shall be filled per Section 50.2 (c).

Section 50.2 (c) In the event the annual session(s) of the Grand Auxiliary cannot be held, the Grand Madam President shall advance to the Jr. Past Grand Madam Presidents position. The Grand Madam President-Elect shall advance to the office of the Grand Madam President. All other Grand Auxiliary Officers shall advance one position in the progression of Grand Auxiliary Officers. The open position of Grand Madam Outside Guard shall be filled by a Past Grand Madam President by appointment of the new Grand Madam President until the next regular session(s) can be held. This transition will occur on the date the convention installation was originally scheduled.
