DEBBIE SHARP:

- ♥ **IRS FORM 990/990N DEADLINE IS OCTOBER 15TH.** This is an IRS REQUIREMENT. There is no charge to file the Form 990N electronically with the IRS. If you are asked to pay a fee, you are not on the correct website! Be sure you are on the irs.gov website when filing!
- ♥ **SECRETARIES: BE SURE YOUR 2020-21 OFFICERS AND AUDITOR ARE INPUT INTO MMS.** Also, ensure YOUR correct e-mail is in MMS as Secretary.
- ♥ **NEW AUXILIARY OFFICER'S HANDBOOK AVAILABLE.** I'm finding many are unaware there is a new Auxiliary Officer's Handbook available from the Grand Aerie Supply Department. They are only \$2.00 each. I would recommend each Auxiliary order one for each of their officers and anyone else interested in becoming an Officer. **SECRETARIES:** Pay special attention to page 32 which shows what records are to kept permanently; seven years then destroyed; or three years then destroyed. There are **many** changes on how long we are **NOW** required to keep books, documents, etc.

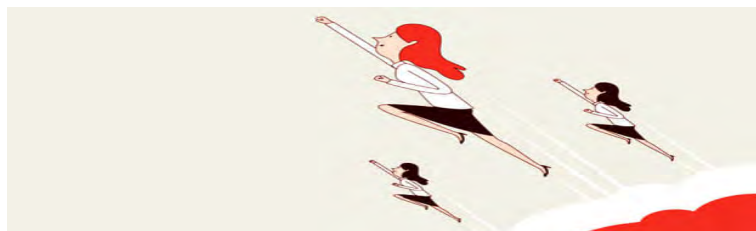
When preparing your nomination, you need to be specific and list all her efforts within the Eagles and in her community. In this submission, details count!
